Stephanie Lou Tolles: Stephanie passed away at her home in Oskaloosa on Sunday, June 22, 2003 from complications of diabetes and kidney failure at the age of 36 years, 8 months and 1 day. At the time of her death, Stephanie had been on kidney dialysis for fifteen months.

Stephanie was a fan of demo derbies and circle 8 races and professional wrestling. She was the type of person everyone loved. She would do everything she could to help anyone who needed her help. Her daughter's friends always called her ""Mom"" and told her how much they loved her. She was employed at the old Oskaloosa Drive-In before it closed, Mahaska Manor and APAC before ill health forced her to stop working.

Stephanie was born Oct. 21, 1966 at St. Francis Hospital in Grinnell, Iowa to Gary and Bonnie Davis Tolles. She attended school in New Sharon and Montezuma before the family moved to Oskaloosa in 1978, where she continued her education.

Stephanie is survived by her daughter, Keri Tolles; her life partner, Scott Piersel; her mother and step-father, Bonnie and Charles Johnson of Brooklyn; her brother, Gary Tolles II of Delta, IA; paternal grandparents, Floyd Tolles of
