Teresa Ashman, 87, of Indianola, formerly of Oskaloosa, passed away on Tuesday, November 11, 2025, at Westview of Indianola Care Center.

Teresa Ann Mitrisin Ashman, daughter of George and Lucille (Lancial) Mitrisin was born on January 15, 1938, in Oskaloosa, Iowa.
