Tikens Binns, 41, of Ottumwa, passed away Wednesday evening, June 30, 2021, at MercyOne Medical Center in Des Moines, Iowa.

Tikens Kurtrisha Michelle Binns, daughter of Jay C. and Virginia (Stinson) Kerr, was born May 23, 1980, in Davenport, IA. Growing up, Tikens attended Knoxville and Oskaloosa High Schools. When she was 17, she met Jeff Binns, and the two were inseparable. Tikens and Jeff married May 6, 2006, and two children were born to this union, Chris and Mercades. Tikens worked in the foodservice industry for multiple restaurants before her retirement in 2016, when she became a full-time homemaker. Tikens was a huge race fan and loved attending the races in Oskaloosa, where she watched her brother compete weekly. Tikens had a spirit that was always overjoyed. She constantly was smiling and always wanted the mood to be light and happy. She was also an avid music lover, but Tikens true love was her family.

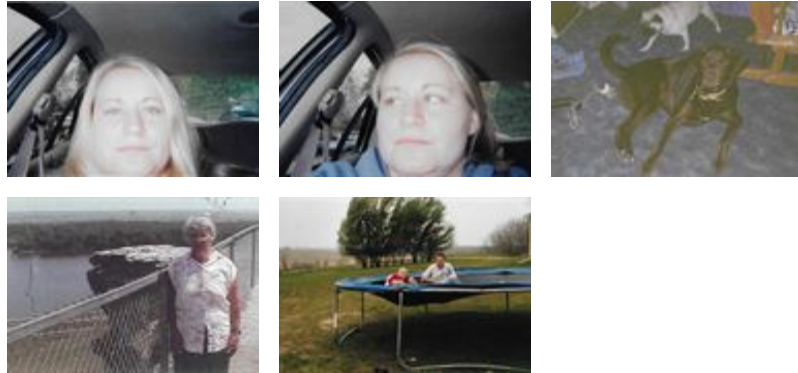
