Virginia Hoy: Virginia passed away late Sunday evening at the Oskaloosa Care Center at the age of 95 years, 3 months and 20 days.

In 1973 she began working at the State Bank of Bussey. Wilbur and Virginia moved from their farm into Oskaloosa in 1977 and Virginia then began working part-time as a teller for Iowa State Bank in Oskaloosa.
