Walter G. Phillips: Walter G. Phillips, 87, passed away Sunday Morning, February 27, 2005 at his home in Oskaloosa. Cremation has been completed, and Memorial Services will be held at a later time, at the convenience of the family.

Walt is survived by his wife Ruth, a daughter Patricia Phillips of Arlington, Virginia; a son Mike Phillips of Chapin, South Carolina; one brother, Bob Phillips of Oskaloosa; and two sisters, Mary Phillips and Barbara Fox, both of Oskaloosa. He is also survived by two grandchildren, Jeff Phillips and Jill Gardner, and one great granddaughter, Emily Gardner, all of Chapin, South Carolina.

Walt was the son of George and Edna (Fritz) Phillips and was born July 3, 1917 in Lacey, Iowa. He married Ruth M. Hall on Valentine's Day, 1942 in Yuma, Arizona. Walt was a career Navy man, having served his country from July, 1936 until his retirement in September, 1958. After his career in the military, he and his family returned to Oskaloosa, where Walt was employed as an electrician. He worked at this occupation until his retirement in 1982 from Wes Anderson Electric.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother.
