Wanda Maxine Nation: Wanda passed away at Windsor Manor Assisted Living in Grinnell, she was 87 years, 1 month and 16 days of age. As was her wish, her body has been cremated. Private family graveside services will be held at Forest Cemetery.

She enjoyed gardening, crocheting, craftwork and spending time with her grandchildren.

In addition to her parents, Wanda was preceded in death by her husband on December 28, 1998; a son, Bill Nation; a brother, Marty White; and an infant sister.
