Genevieve Wharton: Jean passed away Tuesday at Mahaska Hospital at the age of 87 years and 29 days.

September 28, 1974, she married Floyd Earl "Frog" Wharton in Oskaloosa, where they continued to live. After Floyd's death, she made her home at Norwich Apartments until three years ago, when ill health caused her move to Pleasant Park Estates Nursing Home. She was a member of the Rose Hill Community Church, the American Legion Auxiliary, and the V.F.W. Auxiliary. She enjoyed traveling, dancing and camping with friends.
