Wilber Glasgow, 62, of Oskaloosa died Monday evening, September 7, 2020, in a motorcycle/deer accident west on Oskaloosa on Highway 92.

Wilber J. Glasgow, son of Wilber Glasgow Sr. and Darlene (Bishop) Glasgow, was born on August 15, 1958, in Ottumwa, Iowa. Wilbur attended Ottumwa High School. On March 19, 1976, he was united in marriage to Sandra Kay Chrisman at the home of his parents in Ottumwa. Wilber worked at Clow Valve Company for several years and then for Dugger Construction Company. He was last employed at the Comfort Inn in Oskaloosa in maintenance. Wilber was a member of the ABATE Motorcycle Club and the V.F.W. He enjoyed the great outdoors, gardening, hunting, fishing, and riding his motorcycle.
