William Martin Halliburton: Bill was fatally injured in a automobile accident Saturday evening, January 15, 2004 on Highway 63 South of Oskaloosa. He was 64 years, 1 month and 16 days of age.

He is survived by one son, Bill and his wife Melissa Halliburton of Statesville, North Carolina and one daughter, Dee and her husband, Alan Bell of Dunn, North Carolina, also four grandchildren; one sister, Phyllis Anderson of Chesterfield, Missouri and one brother, Jim and his wife, Sandra Halliburton of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, also 8 nieces and nephews.

William Martin Halliburton was born on November 30, 1940 in Oskaloosa, Iowa to Cecil Ray and Lillie Louella Canfield Halliburton . He was a 1958 graduate of Fremont High School, following graduation, he enlisted and served four years in the Navy. He then enlisted in the U.S. Army and served 24 years, retiring in 1984 as a Command Sergeant Major. He served three tours of duty in Vietnam in the infantry and was a recipient of the Silver Star, two Purple Hearts, three Bronze Medals for Heroism and Valor. After his discharge in 1984 he joined the Oskaloosa Police Department, serving from 1985 to 1987. He enjoyed fishing and hunting and riding his Harley Davidson Motorcycle. He is a member of the American Legion and the V.F.W.

He is preceded in death by his parents and one nephew.
