Winnie moved to Oskaloosa as a young child after the death of her mother and she was raised by her uncle and aunt, Mr. & Mrs. Tom Targart. She was a 1926 graduate of Oskaloosa High School and later moved back to North Dakota to care for family members. She eventually returned to Oskaloosa where she married Richard R. Parcell in 1948. He died November 16, 1958. Winnie worked as a sales clerk at the Central Bookstore in Oskaloosa and later as an assistant to the librarian at the Oskaloosa Public Library. She was an avid reader. She was a member of the Central United Methodist Church, D.A.R., King's Daughters and Mizpah Circle.

Besides her parents and her husband, Winnie was preceded in death by her brother Tom Targart, an aunt, Wilma Kentfield and a niece Janet (Targart) Lorentz.
